WHY WATER

Water is essential, yet millions live without it. Water scarcity remains a global crisis and is more than an environmental issue. By supporting water initiatives, Cummins positively influences people's lives through improved health, financial stability, educational outcomes, and quality of life.

THE NEED: Today, about 2.2 billion people lack access to safe water, and 3.5 billion are without safely managed sanitation. One-third of schools do not have basic water and sanitation infrastructure, and women and girls spend approximately 200 million hours every day collecting water.

THE SOLUTION: Cummins Water Works is addressing water scarcity through strategic investments that support local water needs in the communities where our employees live and work. A key part of our Destination Zero strategy, Cummins Water Works has **reached 6.3 million people** since 2021, improving water quality, quantity, and access to WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene).

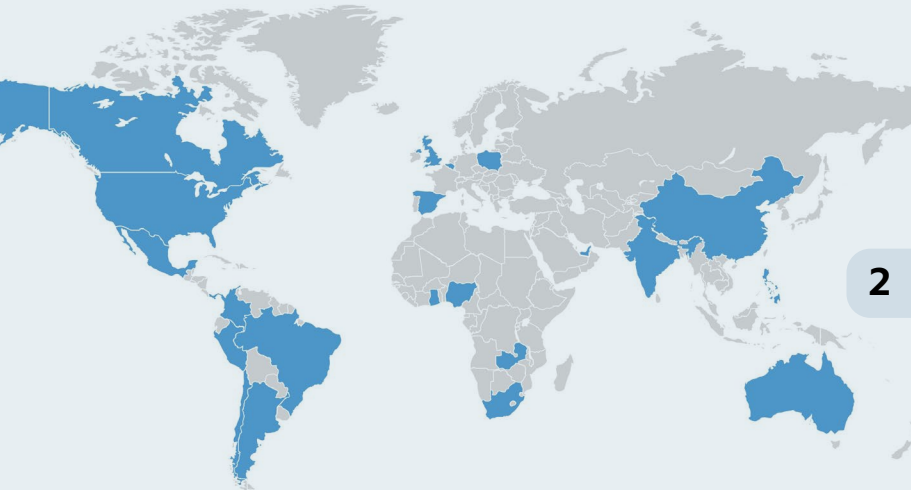

Cummins supports a range of conservation efforts — including tree planting, wetland restoration, invasive species removal, and nature-based solutions — that enhance ecosystems, promote biodiversity, and improve natural water storage and filtration. These initiatives align with our commitment to environmental stewardship.
