Introduction_____

Jacobs Vehicle Systems is pleased to announce the release of a new revision engine brake for the Series 60 11.1L engine. Changes include a new lash setting, a screw terminal on the solenoid and improvements to the housing casting. A new Power-Lash® adjusting screw is also introduced with Model 760B.

Impact _____

Model 760B engine brakes can only be used with 1998 and newer 11.1L Detroit Diesel Series 60 engines. 1997 and older 11.1L Detroit Diesel Series 60 engines require model 760A engine brakes.
